Complete Infrastructure

Outdoor Services of the Sports Park Available

The outdoor facilities of the Sports Park in TSP were completed in November 2005 and opened in February 2006. There are three basketball courts, two tennis courts, one softball pitch, public toilets, pathways, gardens and a playground. The Wellness Center, indoor facilities in the Sports Park, is expected to begin operations in September 2007 with badminton courts, basketball courts, a table tennis room, swimming pool, SPA, gym, sauna and restaurants. It will become one of the best recreational environments for sports and leisure activities in the science park.

Phase II of the Wastewater Treatment Plant in Operation

The Phase II of the Wastewater Treatment Plant in the TSP was tested and certified on February 28, 2006. The Phase I and Phase II plants have a capacity of 90,000 CMD collectively, which is beyond the demand of the TSP with advanced technologies and low pollution emissions.

Fifth-phased Standard Factory Buildings Ready for Tenant Enterprises

The construction of the fifth-phased Standard Factory buildings has been concluded and opened for tenancy from February 2006. The buildings are new, pretty and accessible with complete public facilities. To assist tenants with reducing costs during the initial stages, the buildings have devised detailed designs at the entrances, parking spaces, loading spaces, space for equipment, roads, and landscape construction. New tenants will feel extraordinary convenient and satisfied with the new designs.

Convenient Parking in the Administrative Service Zone

The Central Square Underground Parking at the Administrative Service Zone of the TSP is surrounded by the Administration Building, Service Center, Police Building and National Center for High-Performance Computing. The underground parking spaces were available from December 15, 2006 with 416 cars and 466 motorbikes and meet the demands of the Administrative Service Zone and Park 17. The Central Square bridges the Administrative Service Zone and other areas and can serve as a venue for major outdoor events (maximum capacity: 25,000 people).

More Efforts for a Barrier-free Environment

In order to construct a barrier-free environment, the STSP Administration has set up a "Physically challenged users' movement, facilities and equipment inspection unit". In the future, the STSP will not only be developed according to "Architecture Technology Regulations," a manual on the "Design and Construction of a Barrier-free Environment" will also be created to realize the ideal of a perfect barrier-free environment.

After five months of renovation, the STSP Administration website was available again with new interface on January 1, 2006 and earned the AAA logo. Also, it was registered on the Web Accessibility Service on February 10, 2006 at URL: enable.nat.gov.tw.

Complete Digitization

Digitization has prevailed in Taiwan, and the STSP Administration completed its "STSP Tenant Enterprises Digital Service System" in December 2006. It is expected to be online in March 2007 for tenant enterprises to submit various applications online.

Delta Electronics, Inc., Taiwan's First Green Factory

People heard about Delta Electronics, Inc. throughout 2006 because its Tainan Branch in TSP was granted the first-ever "Green Factory" certification in Taiwan. To win the title, Delta Electronics had to pass nine benchmarks in the categories of Ecology, Energy Saving, Waste Reduction and Health or EEW. The Ministry of the Interior awarded the company "2006 Green Building of the Year" on October 4, 2006 and Mr. Bruce Cheng, Chairman of Delta Electronics, decorated the lobby of the Tainan Branch with the recognition plate.

Book Release: The STSP Business Procurement Guidelines

Customs Service in KSP

The STSP Station of the Ministry of Finance's Kaohsiung Customs Office was established in KSP on July 31, 2006. This Station improves the service of KSP for cargo clearance automation.

In addition to customs services, the Logistics Center of Taiwan Sugar Corporation is also important to the construction of a clearance automation system. Chein Tai, Former Director-general of STSP Administration and Incumbent Deputy Minister of the National Science Council, has made an overall plan for the three Science Parks after he assumed office and promised to request for more resources for KSP in order to enhance the quality of service for tenant enterprises.

Bank of Taiwan, First Bank and Taiwan Cooperative Bank Operating in KSP

Bank of Taiwan, First Bank and Taiwan Cooperative Bank set up operations in the KSP in 2006. Their branches have stationed in the Phase-I Standard Factory buildings, and their operations complete the general investment environment and benefit enterprises recruitment for KSP.

While the KSP is busy recruiting new tenants, a new Special Police Corps was set up to monitor the KSP since January 1, 2006.

Symposium on "USA-Taiwan Cooperation on Export Control" in the STSP

To effectively manage strategic technological products, and allow STSP tenants to gain a better understanding of relevant regulations, the STSP Administration and the Bureau of Foreign Trade cooperated for the first time to organize a symposium on "USA-Taiwan Cooperation on Export Control" on November 15, 2006 in the STSP. The US delegations included representatives from the US Department of State, Department of Commerce, Department of Homeland Security, and Department of Energy. The US delegation introduced and explained control measures while learning about Taiwan's control mechanisms for export and transits.

Award for Practicing Gender Equality

Gender equality at workplaces marks an advancement of the times. In the afternoon of August 28, 2006, the STSP Gender Equality Committee members visited International Nitto Technology Co., Ltd. and Corning Display Technologies TSIP Branch. After the inspection, committee members commended the two companies for their measures to practice gender equality.

The efforts of promoting gender equality regarding workers' rights in the STSP were acknowledged and the STSP Administration was awarded the Championship of the Third Category on December 21, 2006.

A Silver Medal for the Management of Retirement Reserve Funds

The STSP Administration was awarded a silver medal for its retirement management program. The Labour Affairs Council separates the 28 labour administration competent authorities into three categories according to the number of employees and enterprises. The STSP Administration promotes tenant enterprises to create Retirement Reserve Funds whose performance has been acknowledged by the government and thus was awarded Second Place in the Third Category on December 21, 2006.
