With intense cooperation among the construction teams and the utilization of cantilevering and nighttime construction, the STSP/National Highway No. 1 Connective Road Construction Project (Phase I) was successful in avoiding obstruction to existing avenues of transportation, and emerged from among 30,000 entries nationwide to win the 8th Annual Public Construction Golden Quality Award for excellence in quality civil engineering on December 21, 2007. This is the first construction-related award a science park has received upon first submission. The Connective Road is expected to commence operation following the completion of Highway Interchange by the Ministry of Transportation and Communications. The Connective Road will cut down on the employee commute and lower shipping costs for operational effectiveness.
