

Formation of Industry & Commercial Service Clusters

To provide a wide range of services to an ever-expanding number of tenant enterprises, the STSP Administration recruited Fantasy Travel Service Co., Lee and Li Attorneys at Law, PricewaterhouseCoopers, SinoPac Securities, and Digital United Inc., now located on the second floor of Park17, to provide expert financial, tax management, fund-raising, Internet, stock market, corporate law, consultation, and discount travel services.

To increase industry and commercial service diversity and form related clusters in the Commercial and Industrial Services Center, the STSP Administration recruited King Tachi Co., Mingtai Fire & Marine Insurance Co., AIG General Insurance, Ernst & Young, Lion Travel Agency, and InfoPower, to provide Japanese translation, property insurance, information, educational training, commercial auditing, as well as ticketed-travel and itinerary services.
