



Position for the Future,

In order to best prepare for the future, we are focusing on 3 development directions, "Dedication to the development of industry clusters," "Commitment to sustainable development," and "Promotion of culture and arts." We are dedicated to making the STSP into a model of industrial development in Taiwan with a holistic view on the "economy," "environment," and "society." We are and will continue to realize this vision of "sustainable development" with concrete action.

Continuous Development of Industrial Clusters

Promotion of Southern Taiwan Biomedical Device Industrial Cluster Development Plan

In 2012, it is expected that approximately NT\$240 million in subsidies will be used to encourage R&D in advance orthopedic device technologies, dental equipment system technologies, alloy medical technologies, and cosmetic surgery technologies and the organization of relevant seminars such as "Biomedical Device Market Development – Talent, Technology, and Capital Matching."

Advancement of Japanese Industrial Clusters Program

Japanese industrial clusters have long been established at the STSP. By the end of 2011, the STSP Administration had successfully recruited 17 Japanese enterprises such as Toray, Sumika, and Ulvac for an investment amount of NT\$15.99 billion and addition of 3,480 employees. In response to the change brought about by the economic recession, the STSP Administration recently has taken the advantage of investment agreements between Taiwan



and Japan and actively promoted the Advancement of Japanese industrial clusters Program in order to attract more investment by Japanese enterprises at the STSP with the goal of stimulating economic development.

Building Service Clusters

The STSP Administration has renovated 4 shopping districts at the Tainan Science Park as well as other amenities at the Kaohsiung Science Park. Due to its limited operational scale, Kaohsiung Science Park has developed strategic alliances with nearby schools and business operators to provide amenities as well as established the "Kaohsiung Science Park Amenities Promotion Group," which convenes meetings on a regular basis to discuss relevant issues.

Building a Sustainable Environment

Continuous Focus on Creating a "Sustainable Green Science Park"

The STSP Administration has actively assisted Park enterprises to promote green processes and systems including reports on the social responsibilities of enterprises, green house gas emission inventory,

assessment of the carbon footprint of tenant products, local waste processing, utilization of fallen plant leaves and branches, and replacement of all conventional street lamps with LED ones. Hence, the STSP has become the first demonstration green Science Park in Taiwan to meet its commitments to environmental protection and sustainable development.

Promoting Green Trade

In response to tougher global green trade requirements, the STSP Administration has incorporated "Green Trade Consultation Services," "Enhancement of Green Trade Competitiveness," and "Green Trade Marketing Promotion" under the "Green Trade Promotion Program" of the Bureau of Foreign Trade, MOEA to facilitate the participation of Park enterprises in relevant promotional tasks and in Green Classic Model Award in order to help grasp development opportunities for green products and services.

Construction of a Safe and Sustainable Healthy Environment

The "White Paper on Occupational Safety at the STSP" is the first of its kind to be published in 2012. In addition to its

systemic records and reviews of the occupational safety mechanisms and characteristics of the STSP, a database and relevant indicators have also been established and analyzed to strengthen disaster prevention knowledge and skills as well as facilitate the establishment of a safe work environment. Joint emergency respondent abilities have also been improved to mitigate overall disaster risks. Furthermore, the STSP Administration will continue to promote the prevention of employee burnout and health awareness to create a safe, healthy, and sustainable culture at the STSP.

Promotion of Culture and Art

Tainan Science Park has a long and proud tradition of promoting art and culture. It has an area dedicated to public displays of various types of art as well as hosts the Tainan Science Park Public Art Festival. Overall planning of public art displays at the Kaohsiung Science Park and public participation in artistic events are currently being planned. ☒
