



> The 2nd External Strategic Seminar on "STSP Mid-long Term Strategies Development" (October 19)

Participation of Learning Organization in Strategic Planning

The National Cheng Kung University Research and Development Foundation (NCKURDF), on behalf of the Administration, hosted a seminar on June 17 to develop the "STSP Mid-long Term Strategies Development," which was to be innovative and competitive. The Administration's staff had 6 internal meetings with the NCKURDF, analyzing and studying the environment inside and outside of STSP and its competitive advantages as well as development strategies and goals. The results were presented in 3 external strategic seminars where experts, enterprises at the Park and communities offered their opinions. The NCKURDF concluded and summarized the STSP mid long term development prospect, strategic goals, assessment index, and implementing measures. The STSP development prospect is to build a world-class Science Park embodied with innovation, research and development, and comparative advantages of services. As for the 4 strategic themes, they are "Creation of Four Technological Clusters," "Encouragement of Research and Development and Innovation," "Construction of a Well-planned Investment Environment," and "Building a Better Place to Live." The subsequent internal discussion will focus on future prospects, strategies, assessment index, and implementation. Along with the determination to realize its plans, STSP will become a world-class competitive modern park.

Implementation of Performance Bonuses Program

The National Science Council of Executive Yuan has rated the three Science Parks in terms of each Administration, Science and Technology Policy Research and Information Center (NARL), and Instrument Technology Research Center (ITRC) every December since 2003. The Administration was again rated "Excellent" every year by the National Science Council. The Administration pinpointed precisely that it not only had achieved the goals for the current year's 3 main assessment index (increased number of approved enterprises, turnover, and employees), but the figures also grew dramatically. Moreover, the percentage of lease-out land increased and the three industry clusters have taken shape. The amenities in the Park were improved, and the Specialized Team for Foreign Enterprises was established based on innovation and quality services. Moreover, the satisfaction level over STSP surpassed overall ratings. Our efforts were highly recognized.
